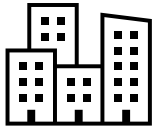


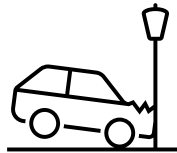

Coffee with a Cop



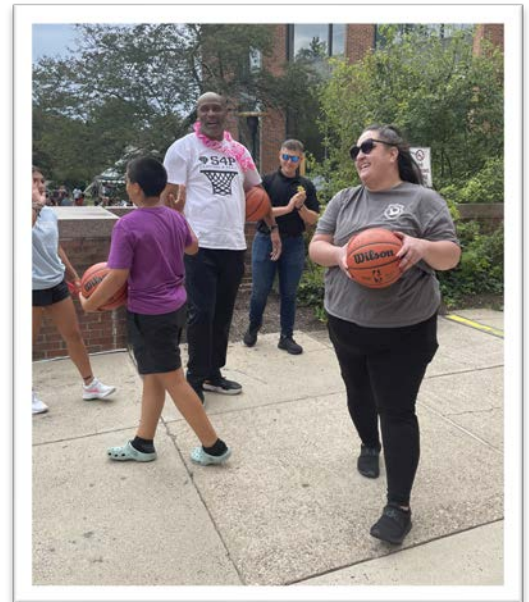
