There are two separate bills lists.

1. The primary October bills list totals \$3,469,278.12. Of that amount, \$1,891,679.66 or 54.5%, is Payroll and Benefits.

The remaining 45.5%, totaling \$1,577,598.46, includes the following payments:

- Rycon Construction for the twenty-fifth release of payment for the general contracting portion of the Municipal Building renovation project for \$551,924.14 (15.9%)
- Delaware Valley Workers' Compensation Trust (DVWCT) for the 4th quarterly payment for 2025 workers' comp coverage and the 2026 Heart & Lung Act policy totaling \$155,104.75 (4.5%)
- Legal and Engineering services and invoicing/releases from project escrows totaling \$90,963.79 (2.6%) *Note: Does not include Obermayer Rebmann, Campbell Durrant, or Jones Engineering Associates presented separately.*
- Olymbec USA (2 mos.) and CORT Furniture for the monthly rental of temporary office space and furniture due to relocation totaling \$86,728.63 (2.5%)
- Electric, Water, Cable/Internet, and Telephone (Utilities) totaling \$82,183.61 (2.4%)
- Payment for the PLGIT Township Debit Card purchases related to various certification/membership renewals, software & support, seminars, and materials & supplies totaling \$58,299.11 (1.7%)
- Myco Mechanical for the twenty-second release of payment for the plumbing portion of the Municipal Building renovation project for \$49,717.06 (1.4%)
- Stambaugh Ness Tech Solutions LLC for managed IT support in the amount of \$44,228.69 (1.3%)
- Selective Insurance for renewal of the Builder's Risk policy needed during construction of the Township Building in the amount of \$33,028 (1%)
- Grace Construction for the Municipal Building renovation project in the amount of \$37,515 (1.1%)
- Kent's Tree Service for tree removal on Village Lane for \$32,257.50 (0.9%)
- Barry Isett & Associates and United Inspection Agency for contracted inspection services in the amount of \$29,345 (0.9%)
- 2. The second October bills list totals \$211,895.30 representing payments made to Jones Engineering Associates (JEA) for Township engineering services and invoicing/releases from project escrows to JEA for various work completed.
